Guide to Parents and Educators



- Younger children (3rd grade and younger) are allowed to express themselves via drawings or a mixture of drawings and text.
- Please avoid giving extensive instructions or examples to children about what to write. Please avoid influencing their thinking.
- Criteria for winning selection: Originality of thoughts and explanations; clarity and cleverness of expressions; completeness in addressing all aspects of our prompt. Qualities that are <u>not important</u> in determining the winners: correctness of spelling or grammar; exactness or beauty of hand-writing or drawings.
- All essay entries MUST BE SUBMITTED VIA EMAIL (SbiaSemahEssay2010@yahoo.com)
- A panel of at least three judges will evaluate each entry individually, and determine the final score of the participant by taking the average of the scores (from 1 to 10, 10 being the highest score). There will be secondary evaluations by other judges should there be a tie.
 - Please make sure that each entry includes FULL NAME (parents/teachers, please make sure the hand writing can be read so misspellings can be avoided), THE GRADE OF THE CHILD and PARENT CONTACT INFORMATION (e-mail or phone number) as well as the SCHOOL where the participant has learned about this event (if from the website of SEMAH or SBIA please mention these as "SBIA website" "SEMAH website").
