SANTA CLARA COUNTY HOMELESS CENSUS & SURVEY

On Tuesday, January 24th and Wednesday, January 25th, Santa Clara County will be conducting our 2017 Point-in-Time Count to better understand the number of homeless individuals living throughout the county. We are in need of community volunteers to work alongside currently or previously homeless guides to count the number of homeless individuals they see across all areas of Santa Clara County. There will be a 1-hour training to prepare you for the count, and you do not need any experience with homelessness.

The data we collect will be combined with shelter and survey data to give us a valid, accurate snapshot of homeless individuals, youth, and families.
